



2024 Standard Club Pool Rules

These policies are subject to change as directed by the Standard Club Board.

Standard Club's pool facilities are private and exclusively for the enjoyment and use of pool members and their guests. Members and guests must adhere to all pool rules, regulations, and signage posted at the pool.

REGISTRATION

- All members are required to sign in at the table by the member entrance gate.
- No coolers of any kind; no outside food or beverages - water bottles & cups must enter empty.
- All bags are subject to being checked by staff while at Standard Club.
- Anyone under the age of 12 must be accompanied by their parent or registered Nanny.
- All members/guests 16 years and older may be required to show a photo ID to the gate attendant for each entry into the pool.
- All guests must be listed by the responsible member's name upon registration.
Guests must always be accompanied by a member and are required to sign in on the guest sheet.
- Babysitters/Nannies are allowed to accompany members' children; however, they must be pre-registered with management and must obey the rules of the pool. If the babysitter/nanny brings non-member children to the pool, the non-member children will be subject to guest fees.
A nanny may only be present and not considered a guest if the parents are unable to accompany their children to the pool. A nanny with the respective member present is considered a guest and will be charged a fee. Nannies do not have member privileges for personal use of the pool.

GUESTS

- All guests 3+ are \$10/person
- Children 2 & under are free
- Guest fees are billed to the accompanying member & no other form of payment will be accepted.
- Standard Club is a private, members-only pool and no unaccompanied guests are allowed.
If members knowingly give information to non-members to enter the pool, membership privileges will be revoked.

CONDUCT

Proper conduct is expected at all times by our members and guests. **Each member agrees to and shall be responsible for the negligent and/or intentional acts of their children and guests.** The Board of Directors may censure, fine, suspend or expel any Member or person in the Member's family whose conduct is found to be injurious to the Club or who has violated any By-laws, Rules, and Regulations. The Board, at its discretion, may authorize the appropriate Standing Committee to investigate any violations and recommend appropriate disciplinary action to the Board.

PARTIES

No parties of any kind are allowed at Standard Club pool.

FOOD

All food and beverages must be purchased from Standard Club and cannot be brought in or delivered.

Food/drink items will be billed to your account. No food or drink may be consumed while in the pool. Plastic or paper service ware only will be offered at the pool as dictated by the Board of Health.

BREAKS

At the top of every hour, for ten minutes, everyone must vacate the pool while lifeguards are on break.

DIVING BOARD RULES

- One person is allowed on each diving board at a time.
- You must immediately swim to the ladder closest to the board jumped from and exit the pool.
- No one is to exit the high dive by going back down the ladder and the next person in line cannot begin to climb the ladder until the person in front of them has jumped.
- The dive well is sectioned off by the rope that runs across the width of the pool. The diving well is to be used only by those going off the diving board. *There is to be no swimming, playing, congregating, or diving off the pool deck in the deep end.*

MISCELLANEOUS RULES

- No furniture is allowed within 5 feet of the pool's edge.
- Adult rafts and floats are not allowed at the pool facilities.
- Bicycles are not permitted within fenced areas.
- No one is permitted to swing golf clubs inside the fenced area.
- No hard rubber footballs, baseballs, volleyballs, etc. allowed in the pool or gated pool area. *Nerf-style and lightweight balls made for the water are still permitted.*
- The pool facilities are smoke-free areas. No smoking of any kind is allowed within the gated area.
- It is the parent's responsibility to see their children pick up after themselves in the restrooms.
- Pool memberships do not include tennis privileges.

RESTRICTED AREAS

Children may not walk on the golf course, play in the sand traps or on the tennis courts, nor congregate by the cemetery area. We ask that parents and guardians know where your children are at all times.

No fishing is allowed below the 12th tee, in a line in front of the 12th green, or in the marked area near the 13th green. Members and guests can fish on the left side of the red pole. Fishing is not allowed from any part of the golf course. *Fishing privileges are extended to pool members Tuesday – Sunday during the pool season only. Fishing is not allowed on Mondays.* Please refer to the Fishing Rules for more information.

BABY POOL

The baby pool is provided for children under the age of six (6) only. Other children may not run in and through the wading pool provided for small children. There is to be no diving in the baby pool. Furniture of any kind is not allowed in the baby pool.

CHILDREN'S USE OF THE POOLS

No children under five (5) years of age are allowed in the large pool unless accompanied by an adult. Children who are not toilet trained must wear Board of Health approved swim diapers at all times in the pool. Children six (6) and over, who in the opinion of the lifeguard, are able to swim up to the standards set for them, shall be allowed in the pool from 10 am until close. *All children using the pool and diving boards must have a proven ability to swim based on the on-duty lifeguards' opinion.*

DIAPERED CHILDREN

Children may not be diapered in the pool area. Parents may diaper children on the changing table provided in pool restroom area.

SAFETY OF INFANTS

Infant seats are permitted at the pool. We urge parents who have babies to use infant seats rather than putting the baby on the ground on a blanket.

SWIM LESSONS

Toilet trained children over three (3) years of age may be given swim lessons in the large pool by the guard. Lessons are given by appointment-only directly with the lifeguard. Lessons will not be given on weekends or on Holidays.

ATTIRE

Bathing suits need to appropriately cover each individual. Wearing appropriate attire at the pool by all visitors is the responsibility of the member. If you have a guest or nanny using the pool, we ask that you make sure appropriate bathing suits are being worn. *Thongs and bathing suits made of mesh or see-through material are examples of inappropriate attire.*

HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS

The pools are regularly inspected by the Health Department and rated as to cleanliness and hygienic conditions at each inspection. Accordingly, members and their guests are required to use the waste receptacles placed around the pool deck for their personal refuse, i.e. drinking cups, paper products, etc.

HOURS

- 10 am to 8 pm Tuesday – Sunday
4 pm – 8pm Tuesday – Friday while JCPS is in session
- Closed on all Mondays, except Holiday Mondays. Closed Tuesday after a holiday.

PARKING

- Parking must be in designated spaces in the main parking lot only.
- Overflow parking will be on the grass hill which will be marked.
- There are two handicap spots near the pool for handicap use only. The other spots by the dumpster are for authorized vehicles only. The driveway leading to the pool must remain clear at all times.

We wish to stress that the Pool Rules and Guest Regulations will be meticulously followed.

Fines may be levied for violations.

Breaking any of the above rules could result in revoking membership privileges with no refund of dues.

We appreciate your attention to the rules and hope everyone has a wonderful, safe summer at the pool.



LAKE/FISHING RULES & REGULATIONS

8 am to 8 pm Tuesday – Sunday

1. No fishing is allowed when Standard Club is closed.
2. No swimming or wading is allowed in the lake at any time.
3. Members and their guests use the lake at their own risk.
4. Shoes are always required around the lake.
5. No fishing is allowed below the 12th tee, in a line in front of the 12th green, or in the marked area near the 13th green. Members and their guests can fish on the left side of the red pole. Fishing is not allowed from any part of the golf course.
6. Members & their guests are responsible for picking up their own trash & leaving the lake area like they found it.
7. Everyone else is subject to State required licensing.
8. No diving equipment or boats of any type are allowed on the lake or on the Club premises.
9. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a person sixteen (16) years of age or older when using the lake area.
10. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times and are subject to a fee equal to the pool guest fee.

Sign in at the pool and register guests.

We wish to stress that the Lake/Fishing Rules & Regulations will be meticulously followed.

Fines may be levied for violations.
